Labor, Delivery and Neonatal Care

At Day Kimball Hospital's Burdick Family Birthing Center, it is the goal of our highly skilled, supportive physicians, midwives, and specially trained nurses to ensure that each family has an exceptional, personalized birthing experience.

Our seven private birthing suites offer access to the latest medical technology in a warm, caring, family-centered environment. Each birthing suite is equipped with the comforts of home, including a private bathroom and shower, flat screen TV, free Wi-Fi, and a personal refrigerator. We encourage the father or support person to take an active role in the birthing experience, and they are welcome to spend the night on a comfortable folding bed.

If a cesarean birth is necessary, there is an ultramodern obstetric operative suite located right within the unit.

The Birthing Center is staffed 24/7 with a group of exceptional, highly trained, Neonatal Nurse Practitioners who are dedicated to providing your baby with outstanding, high quality, compassionate care. They work closely in consultation with local Neonatologists we partner with, ensuring that your baby receives the best and most current treatments available.

Day Kimball Hospital also has a full-time Maternal-Fetal Medicine (MFM) physician on staff. MFM physicians are high-risk pregnancy experts, specializing in the 'un-routine'. For pregnant women with chronic health problems, our MFM physician will work together with your obstetric provider to ensure the best possible care for you and your growing baby.
